

Welcome to Berkeley

UC Berkeley's 178-acre central campus is home to many architectural and historical landmarks and retains much of the tranquil beauty of early California. The campus extends 1,000 acres into the surrounding wooded hillsides to include athletic fields, recreation areas, research facilities, student residence halls, a botanical garden and natural preserve. Get Around at Night

Classes, study, research, meetings or performance events may keep you on campus at night. Travel safely around campus after dark with the help of these free services provided by UCPD.

BearWALK Service

Call 510/642-9255 (2-WALK) after dark and walk with a Community Service Officer (CSO). CSOs are student employees of UCPD, who are trained, uniformed, and carry a

police radio. This service is offered 365 days a year from dusk until 2 a.m. Escort can be provided from campus locations (including residence halls) and to destinations within these service boundaries:

- North: Cedar Street N. East: Prospect / Highland Place
- S. East: Warring
- South: Parker Street
- West: Shattuck Avenue

Call at least 15 minutes before desired pick up. The last BearWALK Service request is taken at 1:45 a.m.

Owl Service

- CSOs offer van transport around campus during the early morning hours. After 3 a.m., call 510/642-6760 to request pick up from your campus location or from a designated Bear Transit shuttle stop. Drop-off boundaries are:
- North: Hopkins/Yolo/Eunice East: Hillside / Prospect
- South: Ashby
- West: Sacramento

Call at least 15 minutes before desired pick up. The last Owl Service request is taken at 5:45 a.m.

UCPD encourages you to use our night safety services, but there may be times when you cannot. If you plan on walking through campus at night, choose well-lighted, welltraveled paths. UCPD recommends the nighttime walking route shown on this map (see other side).

Blue Light Phones


There are more than one hundred emergency telephones on or around campus. All have a blue light. Push the button on the phone or dial 911 and the intercom will connect directly to UC Police dispatch. Use the blue light phone when you need emergency assistance to your location. Every elevator has an emergency phone.
